RULES FOR CIRCUIT AWARD

Must enter and show in the same class to ALL FOUR JUDGES.

ALL-AROUND CHAMPION RULES FOR AWARD IN OPEN, AMATEUR, SELECT, YOUTH

1. All horses MUST show in a halter class to ALL FOUR JUDGES in either Open/O-Performance Halter ~ with any exhibitor; Amateur/Am Select in Amateur/Am-Performance Halter, and Youth/Y-Performance Halter
2. Must show in @ least 3 classes in appropriate division—in 3 or more categories
3. Points earned in Green classes will not count towards All -Around Champion Awards
4. Must show to all FOUR judges.
5. Points tallied and ties broken by AHQA Rules for All-Around Awards.

HIGH POINT LEVEL 1 AMATEUR, LEVEL 1 YOUTH, ROOKIE AND SMALL FRY RULES

1. Do not need to show in halter and if shown any halter points will not count towards the NOVICE, ROOKIE or SMALL FRY High Point.
2. Must show to all FOUR judges.
3. Award based on highest point total not number of classes or categories.
4. Ties will be broken according to AQHA rules.

ALL BREED HIGH POINT AWARDS

All Breed High Point Awards will be awarded to the horse / rider combo with the most points in the all breed classes.

All Breed High Point Adult / Youth & All Breed High Point Small Fry

Peter J. Cofrancesco Jr. Memorial Halter Horse Champion Awarded to the Halter horse with the most points. Sponsored by the Cofrancesco Family

Vida VanGordon Memorial Award for the High Point Sussex County Youth Resident

Dot & Harry Mills Award for the High Point Sussex County Amateur Resident

Eligibility for a Rookie class depends on both the horse and the rider's show records:

For a horse to be eligible to compete in a Rookie-level class, that horse must have earned fewer than 10 lifetime points in that class in any division excluding Level 1 exhibitor points. (Level 1 exhibitor points, are not recorded on a horse's performance record; points are recorded on the exhibitor.) For an exhibitor to be eligible to compete in a Rookie-level class, that exhibitor must have earned fewer than 10 lifetime points in that class in any division. Thus, to compete in a Rookie level class, the horse and rider must each have earned fewer than 10 points in that particular class. (Level 1 amateur/youth points are excluded from the horse's lifetime points.)

The horse and exhibitor must be Rookie eligible per Rule SHW 252.1. / **Please print your AQHA proof of eligibility and have it available for the show secretary at registration.**

BRING PROOF OF VACCINATIONS ALONG WITH YOUR COGGINS TO THE SHOW OFFICE WHEN YOU REGISTER.
