The purpose of the Livestock Education Exhibit is to give Fairgoers an opportunity to view, interact with and learn about a variety of farm animals. While some of these are more typical farm animals and others are unusual, less common animals, all are examples of the vast variety of livestock being raised on Sussex County and NJ farms. This exhibit provides the public with a more interactive and close up experience with the animals and their owners. One of the primary goals of the Ag Division is to educate and promote agriculture and the Livestock Education Exhibit achieves that goal.

### Rules for exhibitors-

- All trailers, trucks should enter the Fairgrounds at the Ag entrance at the top of the hill on Plains Rd.
- **Vehicles with animals should follow the Vet Check signs and proceed through Vet Check. Please have paperwork ready for the Fair veterinarian. No animals will be allowed on the grounds unless they have a CVI and all appropriate paperwork.**
- All animals for the Livestock Education Exhibit should arrive between 8-9 a.m. on Saturday, August 10 and should remain on the grounds until 4:00 on August 11. Animals may leave the grounds between 4-5 p.m. on 8/11.
- All vehicles must be off the grounds by 10:00 a.m. Parking is in the Ag Exhibitor lot.
- Owners of the animals in the Livestock Education Exhibit will be provided with a parking pass and tickets for admission, if needed.
- Bedding is provided, but owners should bring their own feed, buckets, and any items specific to your animals.
- Owners and farms are encouraged to bring a banner, sign or promotional materials for their farm or farm business. Animals may not be sold at the Fair, but Fairgoers can be directed to come to the farm.
  
- **Participating in the Livestock Education Exhibit is at your own risk and that of the health of your animals.**
